Please see below two questions for Project NO CP257-206-1(2019) TWO (2)  
County Roads – Turner Road & Carnes Creek Road:

What Days & Hours will the Contractor be able to work?

Will there be milling into the side streets, if so, how far back?

## **ANSWERS**

Typical work days will be Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.  
Weekend work will be considered case-by-case basis but must be approved by the  
County. No work on established holidays.

The contractor will not be required to mill back into the intersections.

## **QUESTIONS PROJECT CP257-206-1(2019)**

Are trains still running on the tracks at WolfPit and Turner Road?

Will the Contractor start the milling before the RR crossing or cross over the RR Crossing and  
begin Milling on Turner RD?

Will the paving stop at the seam or the stop sign on Carnes Creek?

Can the stop sign be removed and replaced back after Milling on Carnes Creek / SR184 ?

1. Will the County be responsible for the Temporary Stripping on both roads?
2. Will the County require post mounted signs on the adjoining highways
3. Will a Railroad Flagger be required
